



What You Need to Know as a Parent

- ❖ Grace Acres happens every Sunday at 9 AM and 11 AM in the cafeteria.
- ❖ All of our volunteers go through an application process and background check.
- ❖ Please notify someone at the check-in table of any allergies your child might have. We serve Cheerios, animal crackers, and pretzels in our classes. If there is a week that we have additional snacks, there will be an Allergy Alert poster beside the check-in table.
- ❖ We now have a Parent Resource area that coincides with the Volunteer Table. Please feel free to pick up any materials that are placed at this table. Our goal is to be able to communicate information to you clearly and answer any questions you may have.

Classes-

Lambs- Newborn to Walkers (once your child is able to walk steadily, they will move to the next room)

Piglets- Walkers to 2 years old

Chicks- 2 year old

Ducks- 3 year old

Ponies- 4 & 5 years old (once your child begins kindergarten, they will move to Cross Street)

Arrival/Departure-

Please remember to get a numbered tag for your child at the check-in table. If this is your first time, you can go to the Visitor Table for assistance.

When you drop off your child, please remember to:

- Have your child's tag placed on their back and numbered stub in your hand
- Label all belongings

-Give any specific instructions to the volunteer/ If you are dropping off in the Lambs class, please fill out the baby info sheet!

-Please take your child to the bathroom before dropping them off in the classroom

We provide you with a take home card each week and magnet that you can use throughout the week. This week, make sure to ask your child questions about what they did and what they learned in Grace Acres today!
